From the Dean's Desk

A paper presented at the Meeting of the Parish Church Council of the Parish of St. George and St. Andrew on Saturday, 14th January, 2012 at the Pastoral Centre, New Montrose, Kingstown, St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

THE FORWARD MOVEMENT OF THE PARISH

Every Member of the Parish Church Council has been given a special privilege at this time 'to serve' in the administrative position in God's Church. But it is a privilege that calls on every member to take on the responsibility of the life of God's Church with dedication, commitment, faithfulness, loyalty and with the promise to serve to the end. It may seem a wearisome task but remember, we are empowered by God to do so.

Never allow the problem to arise where we disconnect culture from our religion. The time is now for us to reconnect our culture with our faith as we see the danger where our faith is on trial. Let no member of the Council hold the belief that the time has not come for the reforming of our structures in Mission, Ministry, Stewardship and Evangelism. The things that were and are done, in a rigid, non-consultative manner can no longer enhance Mission, Ministry, Stewardship and Evangelism. It will not work in the context of our time. We have to come to terms with the modern world. However, we need to hold our historical faith, while, at the same time, renew the structures. We have a mandate from God "to make all things new" - to bring people to **'an abiding relationship with God'**.

It must never be seen that in our thrust for change that there is a revelation of a "shallow-watered down" Christian Faith. For the signs are revealing and witnessing to the steady advancement of the destructive forces that are present with us. Individualism is destroying the corporateness of life. No one says that we must not affirm ourselves and maintain our worth and values, but we must safeguard the "building up of the 'Body of Christ' - the Church of God. We must pursue the things that make for peace, justice, love and joy, fellowship and togetherness, unity and harmony, that build up 'the common life'. Secularism, materialism and drugism are also menacing forces in modern societies. And there is a rapidity of them through modern technology. If we are to allow these forces to advance without stoppage through proper education of our people, then we will be in danger of losing all 'good' values of life.

Therefore, it is the Council's responsibility to put a plan in place to lessen or avert the danger and destruction that these forces are presenting. 'Calls' must be made and followed-through. And the first call is "TO WORSHIP" and "TO PRAY". Hence all Councillors must be a 'sign' to the rest of the laos- the people of God in their commitment to worship and the receiving of the Blessed Sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood every Lord's Day and at other Feast Days when it is possible.

Leadership involves action. For the mission and focus of the Parish must be manifested through its leadership, by seeking to mobilize the organizations of the Church; we must work with the Mothers' Union, Anglican Church Women Association (ACWA), Men's Fellowship, Communicant Association, Youth and others. It is to get all persons participating in the activities of the Church.

Our Christian Education Programme must be better structured to reach the youth before and after Confirmation. And our Bible Study programme must be promoted by all members of Council. For without such empowerment programme we are opening ourselves to be asked questions which we cannot answer. And which, perhaps, are some of the questions that give rise to violence, disharmony, the breakdown of true moral and ethical values in family life.

Whatever we may set out to do, the finance of the Parish enhances the growth and development of the Parish. What we do with our properties must be the care and concern by all

Councillors, and also how we raise our monies.

There is the need for all Councillors to communicate the realities of the financial situation that prevails in the Parish at this time. It is your duty to seek words from the 'Church' in a consultative manner, what ought or can be done to advance the financial progress of the Parish.

Councillors, we have the call 'to make all things new'. And with God, all things are possible if we trust Him.

May this year of your tenureship reveal that you are some of God's people whose hearts He has touched.

Appendix

The Restoration Programme of the St. George's Cathedral is an ongoing discussion of the Council and the "Restoration Committee". However, we must keep in focus that the amount of funds needed for the 'Restoration' of the St. George's Cathedral, including all contingencies will amount to approximately \$2.5 Million (EC dollars). Let us work much harder this year, to start the Restoration work on St. George's Cathedral. United we stand, divided we accomplish nothing. Stand together for what we believe. And we do believe that, with God's grace, love by all, far and near, that through our gift we can accomplish the task.
